Have some time? These nearby attractions are all within walking distance of America's Center.



ATTRACTION & ACTIVITY INFORMATION

- 1 ST. LOUIS UNION STATION** | *on site*
1820 Market Street | stlouisunionstation.com
National Historic Landmark. At the stunning 1894 train station, experience the 3D light show and a fire and light show. Other highlights include the St. Louis Aquarium, featuring thousands of aquatic species from the rivers and oceans of the world and the St. Louis Wheel, a 200-foot-high observation wheel with enclosed, climate-controlled gondolas offering views of the St. Louis skyline. A Carousel, Mini Golf, Mirror Maze, Selfie Express and a Ropes Course also call the Station home.
- 2 ENERGIZER PARK** | *4 minute walk*
2100 Market Street | stlouiscitysc.com
Open-air soccer stadium, home to the MLS St. Louis CITY SC. Energizer Park is a space where architecture, green spaces and gathering places come together organically to inspire our city.
- 3 SOLDIER'S MEMORIAL MILITARY MUSEUM**
10 minute walk
1315 Chestnut Street | mohistory.org/memorial
The newly restored Art Deco monument is St. Louis' tribute to the military offering free exhibits dedicated to the stories of local military service members, veterans, and their families.
- 4 CENTRAL LIBRARY – ST. LOUIS PUBLIC LIBRARY**
11 minute walk

Tour one of St. Louis' most spectacular buildings and one of America's great public libraries. Rotating exhibits on site and guided architectural tours are available on Mondays and Saturdays.
- 5 CAMPBELL HOUSE MUSEUM** | *11 minute walk*
1508 Locust Street | campbellhousemuseum.org
Once a three-story townhome owned by one of St. Louis' most prominent residents, Robert Campbell. Many family furnishings have been retained, making it a showcase of Victorian furnishings and decorative arts.
- 6 CITY MUSEUM** | *15 minute walk*
750 North 16th Street | citymuseum.org
With secret caves and passageways, a small circus, an architectural museum, a museum of oddities and plenty of slides, City Museum is a recycler's paradise with many of the exhibits constructed from products that were made for other uses.
- 7 CITYGARDEN** | *17 minute walk*
801 Market Street | citygardenstl.org
A free sculpture park oasis featuring lush plantings and internationally renowned sculpture. Download Citygarden's free mobile app for a tour.
- 8 BALLPARK VILLAGE** | *20 minute walk*
601 Clark Avenue | stlballparkvillage.com
Adjacent to Busch Stadium is the St. Louis Cardinals themed entertainment and dining district featuring the Cardinals Hall of Fame & Museum.
- 9 BUSCH STADIUM** | *20 minute walk*
700 Clark Avenue | mlb.com/cardinals/ballpark
Home of the 11-time World Series Champion St. Louis Cardinals with sweeping views of the Gateway Arch. Tours are available year-round.
- 10 WASHINGTON AVENUE/MX DISTRICT**
20-25 minute walk
618 Washington Avenue | mxstl.com
One of downtown's most popular gathering places, featuring restaurants, shops, and entertainment in the convention corridor including the MX Movies and The Flamingo Bowl bowling alley.
- 11 KIENER PLAZA PARK** | *21 minute walk*
500 Chestnut Street | archpark.org/visit/points-of-interest
A gathering spot in the heart of downtown with a playground and fountains.
- 12 OLD COURTHOUSE** | *22 minute walk (reopens May 2025)*
11 North 4th Street | nps.gov/jeff/planyourvisit/och.htm
The Old Courthouse, located just steps from the the Arch, was the site of two notable court cases: Dred Scott's fight for citizenship and Virginia Minor's case for a woman's right to vote.
- 13 NATIONAL BLUES MUSEUM** | *24 minute walk*
615 Washington Avenue | nationalbluesmuseum.org
The museum includes galleries and interactive exhibits covering the various influences of American music and blues legends.
- 14 INSIDE THE ECONOMY MUSEUM** | *25 minute walk*
1 Federal Reserve Bank Plaza | museum.stlouisfed.org
Inside the historic Federal Reserve Bank of St. Louis, you can learn more about the economy through nearly 100 interactive displays, games, sculptures and videos.
- 15 OLD CATHEDRAL** | *26 minute walk*
209 Walnut Street | oldcathedralstl.org
The Old Cathedral, located south of the Arch, is the oldest Cathedral west of the Mississippi River. Open for daily Masses.
- 16 GATEWAY ARCH NATIONAL PARK** | *27 minute walk*
11 North 4th Street | gatewayarch.com
The Gateway Arch is an iconic monument symbolizing the westward expansion of the United States. Take a tram to the top, watch a documentary film, take a virtual reality tour or explore the museum. Or enjoy other riverfront attractions such as riverboats, the Paddle-wheel Cafe or helicopter tours.
- 17 FIELD HOUSE MUSEUM** | *28 minute walk*
634 South Broadway | fieldhousemuseum.org
Poet Eugene Field's boyhood home furnished with many items that belonged to the Field family, and while living there his father Roswell M. Field served as the attorney who took Dred Scott's freedom suit into the Federal Courts.
- 18 LACLEDE'S LANDING** | *30 minute walk*
710 North 2nd Street | lacledeslanding.com
A cobble-stoned entertainment district just north of the Gateway Arch along the Mississippi River featuring restaurants, live music clubs and Horseshoe Casino. Visit the website for a self-guided walking tour.
